ENTRIES AND FEES

ONLINE REGISTRATION: Registration for all categories will take place on the Skate Nova Scotia Uplifter website: skatecanadans.uplifterinc.com March 2 to 4, 2025 (PEI skaters with a bye must register March 2 to 4, 2025. (Those who qualify at SC PEI Provincials must register March 10)

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

Methods of payment include: VISA, MasterCard are accepted. Music must be uploaded at the time of registration in a MP3 format with the correct skater's full name and full category.

MEDALS

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

A tentative Schedule of Events will be sent to each Section the week of March 11, 2025. The competition will resume on time after each flood.

REGISTRATION – On site

Registration will take place throughout the weekend at the RBC Centre. Skaters must register at least 1 hour before their event is scheduled to begin.

MUSIC

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by the Performing Rights Society.

Competitors who have music composed especially for their programs, either in whole or in part, shall be responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and television, or appropriate clearance from the Performing Rights Society.

Competitors must have their backup music on a USB at rink side.

Alternate electronic items such as iphones, tablets, etc will not be accepted.

All USB's must only include one program.

Competitor's name and category shall be marked clearly on the device.

COACHES ACCREDITATION

Coaches must be Regional Coach in training and must meet the following accreditation standards:

- be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada in good standing

It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at the competition and always have accreditation visible during the competition to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 upon presentation of current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.

There may be a maximum of two coaches at rink side per skater.
